

NEW Youth Transit Pass



\$52 Transit Pass for Youth ages 13-17 starts August 15th

In December 2017, as part of the annual budget update process, City Council approved a 22-month pilot that will provide youth ages 13-17 with a transit pass for \$52 per month. This pilot will begin on September 1st. Here are some things to know about the new program:

- Youth Passes can be purchased at one of eight City locations OR one of two LTC Locations ([see next page for complete list of locations](#))
- Youth Passes can be purchased beginning on August 15th for purchase of September bus passes
- To participate in this program, youth will be given a new Smart Card that is specifically coded as a youth card in the LTC's system
- After the initial purchase, Youth Passes **can be purchased online** through the LTC website at www.londontransit.ca
- ID will not be required at the time of purchase, but riders may be required to show their valid Secondary School ID OR government-issued photo ID at the time of boarding
- Student Tickets will still be available for purchase (5 for \$7.70) at LTC locations and existing LTC vendor locations

What does a resident need to purchase a Youth Bus Pass online?

The initial purchase for a Youth Bus pass must be done at one of the locations listed above. This is so that residents can be provided with a Youth Smart Card. It will not be possible to purchase a Youth Pass using an existing Smart Card.

After the first Youth Pass has been purchased, the resident can use the Smart Card they have been provided to purchase the Youth Pass online at www.londontransit.ca each month.
